- 5. In Sunday's message, Pastor Ryan unpacked FOUR of the most dangerous "flaming arrows" that Satan and his forces are known to shoot at Christians. Explain these four arrows in your own words—and then discuss how "the shield of faith" can be used to achieve victory over these attacks.
