2.	Read Philippians 2:1-11. Notice that in most Bible translations, verses 6-11 are typically set apart as a unique or special paragraph. Most Bible scholars believe that these verses were probably a hymn or a song sung by the ancient Christian church. In your own words, what is the over-arching theme of this song?
3.	What counsel does Paul give the Philippian Christians in verses 3-5? What kinds of actions did they need to be living out in their everyday Christian relationships? How can Christian people be guilty of "looking to their own interests" (selfishness) while neglecting the needs of others? Give some real-life examples.
4.	At the end of end of verse 5 who is the ultimate example of the humble, giving, other-centered kind of lifestyle?
5.	As you consider verses 6-8, how exactly did Jesus demonstrate this attitude of humility? As you remember this biography of Jesus, how do we see His humility and lowliness demonstrated again and again?

	c. How was his three-year ministry marked by humbleness?
